1 Police Report

4 Approval of Previous Minutes

5 Matters Arising from Minutes

• **Automatic Defibrillator** The defibrillator is now in place in the community hall vennel. Training sessions are to be organised in the next few weeks.

- **Resilient Communities Plan** A clash of dates meant that the last meeting had had to be cancelled. Another is being organised in the near future.

- Queen's Diamond Jubilee Oak Tree The plaque has now been fitted to the wall near the tree.
- Village Christmas Lights A letter was sent to residents in properties in the vicinity of the clock tower seeking permission to erect lights. At the time of the meeting 6 from 20 replies had been received. It was hoped that some funding would be available for lights to be purchased for this Christmas. - War Memorial The memorial has been professionally cleaned and a quotation for painting the railings has been passed to SBC. SBC will lay fresh gravel before Remembrance Sunday. The trees surrounding the monument have still to be felled. It was agreed to explore the possibility of painting the roadside railings using the SBC Local Small Schemes funding.

- Play Park There was still no further information about the high bars on the equipment or the flooding problem. SB Local had been contacted regarding the bank on the north side which needs to be grassed. RB agreed to pursue this.
- **Bus Service 253** Perrymans indicated that a revised service commenced on 1st September. The bus to Edinburgh leaves at 0906 M-F and returns to the village at 1709. A later bus from Edinburgh will call into Ayton by request.
- New Development in High Street SBC had been contracted to reinstate the pavement and the work is now complete. An existing lamp post is now situated towards the centre of the pavement and could cause an obstruction. It was agreed to wait until the houses were occupied before considering this further.

- **Floral Gateway Competition** During the meeting news arrived that Ayton had been placed first in the Small Village section. It was agreed that those travelling to the presentation should claim petrol expenses from the CC.
- Ayton Law to Jubilee Bridge Right of Way SBC had coordinated the reopening of the path which has recently been cleared. Signs are still to be erected and some drainage work carried out.
- Safer Route to School Path. Some of the tarmac has broken up and is need of minor repair. MC agreed to pursue this.
